Dashboard Legend




On Track= We do not plan to discuss item unless there is something unexpectedly positive to highlight or a Board member wishes to discuss it

Needs Attention = Item needs the Board's attention urgently and may require a Board-level decision or action










Trends in LOIs, Applications, and Awards




Funds Announced for Broad Solicitations Compared with Funds Awarded












We continue to strive for a 50% improvement in year-over-year traffic. A dip in November activity pulled down our Q4 average



Social Media


