PCORI Funding Announcements (PFAs) are designed to solicit applications for proposals to support a portfolio of comparative clinical effectiveness research (CER) based on our [National Priorities for Research and Research Agenda](#).

Each priority represents a line of research inquiry that addresses unmet needs of patients, their caregivers, clinicians and other healthcare system stakeholders in making personalized healthcare decisions across a wide range of conditions and treatments.

Projects below were approved under Cycle II of the broad PFAs associated with the first four of PCORI's national research priorities (PFAs associated with PCORI's fifth national research priority are on a different funding schedule).
