# Individual patient data

- Empowers patients to see where they are-every patient feels unique
- Allows for transparency
- Promotes shared-care decision making so patients may better understand displayed data and can actively participate
- May assist with monitoring and management
- Real-time reporting and EMRs



# Clinical trial/Comparative effectiveness research

- Evaluate the effectiveness of various treatments and procedures
  - Helpful to compare Treatment A to Treatment B
  - What interventions work best for various subsets
  - Better understanding of outcome metrics and potential side effects
  - Aids in discussions of what is important



### **Quality indicators**

- Improvement of the patient experience
- How will success be measured
  - Higher symptom burden ≠ better outcomes

#### Conclusion

- Patient-reported outcomes can improve communication
- This may lead to
  - Greater satisfaction
  - Improved adherence to care
  - Potentially could influence outcomes
