STUDY SPOTLIGHT: CARE TRANSITIONS

Care Transition Intervention to Reduce Hospital Use

The transition home after an emergency department (ED) visit, if poorly managed, can lead to hospital admissions or a return to the ED. This is especially true for patients with chronic medical conditions. This project compares a community-based system of social support and medical follow-up with the usual ED practice of verbal and written discharge instructions. The study is determining which transition program is more effective at reducing returns to the hospital and improving quality of life. The project is based at the University of Florida.
