STUDY SPOTLIGHT: DIABETES

Comparative Effectiveness of Pre-Diabetes Approaches in the Rural Latino Populations

Pre-diabetes is becoming rampant in the US population, particularly in the Latino community. This project’s goal is to build a partnership with the Idaho Ventanilla de Salud—a health program for Latinos living in the US—to engage providers, researchers, and patients in developing a Latino-centered pre-diabetes comparative effectiveness project that will enhance pre-diabetic Latinos’ ability to make informed choices to improve their health.
