STUDY SPOTLIGHT: CANCER

Comparing Treatment Options for Women with Low-Risk Breast Cancer

This study is comparing outcomes among women diagnosed with ductal carcinoma in situ (DCIS), a very early form of breast cancer, who receive surgery or radiation versus those of women who instead undergo active surveillance of their condition.
