## STUDY SPOTLIGHT: COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING

### Impact of Information: Comparing Decision Aids for Colorectal Cancer Screening

Little information is available about how best to educate patients about various colorectal screening methods and their trade-offs. Colorectal cancer often can be prevented or treated if detected through regular screening. This project aims to determine how well two decision aids, a DVD alone and in combination with help from a patient navigator, support patients in making decisions. This study is led by scientists at Indiana University.
