STUDY SPOTLIGHT: OBESITY

Comparing Three Ways to Treat People with Obesity in Rural Areas

This study is comparing three treatment approaches for obesity in rural primary care settings: regular visits at a health clinic, teams of health professionals working together to manage patients' needs at clinics, and group counseling by phone. The study is based at the University of Kansas Medical Center Research Institute.
