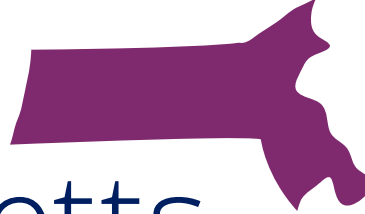

STUDY SPOTLIGHT: OBESITY

Strategies for Improving BMI in Children with Obesity

This study found that children who were overweight or obese achieved healthier weights after their parents received information about behavior change either with or without tailored health coaching, and their clinicians got help counseling families.
