STUDY SPOTLIGHT: MULTIPLE CHRONIC CONDITIONS

Rural Options at Discharge Model of Active Planning (The ROADMAP Study)

For rural residents with multiple chronic conditions, getting to a hospital and then getting back home to recover can be a barrier to care. The specific aim of this research is to involve patients and rural providers in designing and testing interventions to help hospitals connect patients with local resources to aid in their care transitions.
