## STUDY SPOTLIGHT: RESPIRATORY DISEASES

### Comparing Treatments for a Rare Lung Disease

Noncystic fibrosis bronchiectasis is a rare lung disease that causes long-term disability. About 100,000 older Americans have the disease, which causes bacterial growth and inflammation of the lungs. Research has not yet discovered how well treatments for the condition work or how safe they are over the long term. This study is comparing the benefits and harms of a steroid to antibiotics for patients with noncystic fibrosis bronchiectasis. The study is led by researchers at Oregon Health and Science University.
