STUDY SPOTLIGHT: OPIOID USE DISORDERS

Patient-Centered Care for Opioid Use Disorders in Federally Qualified Healthcare Centers

This project is determining whether integrating treatment for opioid use disorders into primary care settings is effective for low-income patients receiving treatment at federally qualified health centers. The study is comparing standard care, which includes support from a social worker and referrals to local outpatient treatment programs, with a program called Personalized Addiction Treatment to Health (PATH). PATH involves onsite treatment at a health center and uses several evidence-based practices, such as cognitive-behavioral relapse prevention and medication-assisted treatment. The study is led by a team at the Treatment Research Institute, in Philadelphia.
