STUDY SPOTLIGHT

Developing Ways to Study Communication between Patients and Healthcare Providers

Patients who can speak openly with clinicians about their care are more likely to get the care they want and need. A new method for studying how patients and clinicians communicate, called statistical natural language processing, makes studying these conversations faster and easier. This method uses computers to look for meaning in conversations by looking at words and phrases and how people use them. The study aims to develop ways to use natural language processing to study the quality of interactions between patients and clinicians.
