STUDY SPOTLIGHT: MENTAL/BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Improving the Quality of Care for the Wyoming Parkinson’s Disease Community-Tier III

The Wyoming Parkinson’s Project seeks to improve the lives of those with Parkinson’s disease. Tier III PCORI Pipeline to Proposal funding supports the project as it uses the comparative clinical effectiveness questions stakeholders developed with their Tier II award and develops proposals for conducting rigorous clinical effectiveness research on Parkinson’s disease across Wyoming. Clinical effectiveness research themes the research will focus on include alternative engagement strategies to address medication therapy management, in-person and web-based delivery strategies for physical exercise programs, and the use of telehealth platforms to provide speech-language pathology treatments in remote or weather-confined areas.
